Cedric: Grade = A (96.9%) Monster Points = 13
ANOTHER GREAT GAME! Once again you got the highest grade & 13 Points

Eskam: Grade = A (96.4%) Monster Points = 3
Great Job - this week we'll see if you are ready to start playing with the 1st offense

Hunt: Grade = B (93.5%) Monster Points = 17
 Great job on run blocking and being aggressive, but we definitely need to work on Pass Blocking assignments & technique - If you don't take a big 1st step you won't be in position to pickup a blitzing LB'r

Larwood: Grade = B (93.6%) Monster Points = 10
 By far your most aggressive game this year. On play 16 (28 Toss) you played it as well as it can possibly be done and got 2 Monster points. Note - on 'Cowboy' your first responsibility is 'inside gap DL', only go down field if you're inside gap is clear.

Richards: Grade = C+ (89.4%) Monster Points = 3
 You had a hard time, but I am proud of the way you kept **fighting**. Note - Cowboy 'away from you' - first responsibility is 'playside gap DL and then LB'r. Slick X to your side with no TE - you are the 'X' guy and DE is '111', block inside (LB'r)

Thomas: Grade = A (96.4%) Monster Points = 7
 Great job (especially Pass Protection) against a difficult defensive alignment

Vance: Grade = A (96.3%) Monster Points = 6
 You did a great job with a very difficult task (BIG D-Lineman in your playside gap)
